Current law allows such rights to all subjects of a child abuse report. However the bill also requires DHS to provide all other subjects, as defined in Code section 235A.15, subsection 2, with an opportunity to intervene in the contested case proceeding. The bill further provides that upon the request of any party to the contested case proceeding, the presiding officer may stay the hearing until the conclusion of the adjudicatory phase of a juvenile case or a district court case that is related to the data or findings. The bill states that an adjudication of a child in need of assistance or a criminal conviction in district court that is related to the data or findings may be determinative in a contested case proceeding. The bill provides that a party to a contested case proceeding has 10 days to file an appeal from the proposed decision of the presiding officer of the contested case proceeding to the director of the department of human services.
